## Harvard Model UN Australia International Conference

Last term, Year 10 student Patrick Chopping represented TCC at the Harvard Model United Nations Australia (HMUN) annual international conference held in Sydney. The largest MUN (Model UN) in the southern hemisphere which is hosted by students currently studying at Harvard University. Patrick along with 500 other students from across the globe represented a country and served on their council/committee.

Patrick (as a delegate from the Australian Team) represented the Democratic republic of Congo and was an ambassador to represent the country's interests and sit on the legal counsel with 22 other delegates tasked with crafting solutions surrounding the responsibility of multinational tech

corporations in ensuring human rights obligations are upheld in supply chain sourcing including the responsibilities of U.N. member-states for consistent human rights standards, implementation, and enforcement.

For his efforts at this event, Patrick received a certificate of participation and had his resolution to the issue passed by a two thirds majority vote.

Patrick will now be traveling to the USA in January/February of 2026 where he will compete in upwards of 5 international conferences with thousands of students from across the globe.
